We are pleased to be caring for a 25 acre coffee and citrus farm with a river and pond in the beautiful Central Valley of Costa Rica.

You are invited to share this tranquil rural setting and to help raise food, learn Spanish, teach English and immerse yourself in the culture of this peaceful country. Your presence can benefit others by bringing your known skills and your enthusiasm for both teaching and learning.

Because the farm is located in the tropical highlands of Central America, there are farming projects that are ongoing year round. We have basic accommodations at a rustic 2 bedroom house with electricity, running water, stove, refrigeration and food growing at your doorstep. Because we are located near a small village, you can experience life moving at a slower pace with few complications.

On the western slope of the continental divide the weather is very agreeable with daytime temperatures in the mid 80's and nighttime temperature in the 50's. We are located in an area with very few insects.

We are seeking volunteers willing to stay for one month or longer who can work thirty hours a week in exchange for accommodations and some of your food.
